II. MINUTES

Minutes of the committee's July 13, 2018 meeting were approved.

III. CHAIR REPORT

Chris Ford told Chair Oswald that Public Affairs would have to approve any comment we submit to Board Chair Wold regarding the rule review; and the next Public Affairs meeting is September 21 (they won't meet again until November – viz., past the Board's October 31 deadline).

Keith Semple noted that in the past the L&R committee would look at this, and might invite comment from practitioners. More often than not, however, the EC has not submitted a comment.

At Chair Oswald's suggestion Keith will contact Board Chair Wold to see whether we might get an extension.

Christine Ford indicated that Susan Grabe had told her that we could circulate the rule review material to Section membership, and invite their comment – Keith will also ask Chair Wold about this.

IV. TREASURER REPORT

Treasurer Conratt submitted Treasurer Reports for the Seven Months Ending July 31, 2018 (Ex. A); and the Eight Months Ending August 31, 2018 (Ex. B), both of which are attached.

V. COMMITEE REPORTS

A. Professionalism Award

There was no report from the Professionalism Award committee.

B. Access to Justice

Jovanna Patrick reported that the September Access to Justice meeting was canceled due to lack of a quorum. At the committee's next meeting on October 8, 2018 they will have Bar representative Matt Shields to discuss the scope of the committee's mandate.

Secretary Smith reported that the board's Advisory Committee expects to finalize its report on the two proposed rule concepts by the end of October.

C. Salishan/Annual Meeting

Geoff Wren is soliciting ideas for presentations at next year's Salishan conference. There is nothing in the works at this time.

Colin Andries indicated that the Bar is looking for diversity among speakers.

D. Bench Bar Forum

Allison Lesh reported that the Bench Bar committee has three primary speakers lined up for this year's program. First, Dr. Danielle Erb, a board-certified Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation specialist at Legacy Good Samaritan Medical Center, who will address traumatic brain injury. Next, Portland attorney Jennifer Bouman-Steagall, who will speak on employment law. Finally, Ron Atwood will speak on issues related to unrepresented claimants. Allison also indicated that SAIF attorney Katie Krametbauer is looking for interesting stories from the trenches. (If you have stories you can email them to Allison).

E. Going Forward

Chair Oswald reported that Spencer Aldrich working at setting up a joint social event with the Young Lawyers Division, and he will report back when the date is finalized. Oswald indicated that he will be asking the EC to consider making a \$200 contribution for this outreach at October meeting.

F. Legislative and Rules

Keith Semple had no report from the Legislative and Rules committee, but indicated that the he expects to convene a meeting of the committee prior to the EC's October meeting.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

Colin Andries reported that the Bar has approved an amendment to MCLE rules, to required a mental health/substance abuse education requirement, effective January 1, 2019.

Colin also informed the committee that the Bar is being sued by two Oregon State Bar members who are challenging the mandatory bar membership provision of the Bar. The challenge derives from the US Supreme Court's recent decision in *Janus v. AFSCME*, which held that the State's extraction of agency fees (union dues) from non-consenting public employees violates the First Amendment.
