Todd was born September 17, 1942 in Los Angeles California and died December 18, 2020 at his retirement home in Central Oregon. He earned his undergraduate degree from Oregon State University and his juris doctorate degree from Northwestern School of Law in 1977. Prior to becoming a member of the Oregon State Bar, he worked in law enforcement with the LA Sheriff's Department and the California Highway Patrol.

He joined the law practice of Al and Rick Roll and spent most of time practicing on the northern Oregon coast, including workers' compensation, social security, and personal injury cases. Todd was respected by his peers was known as a "man of his word." He traveled regularly to Hawaii and to Kodiak Island to fish. In Central Oregon, he volunteered at 3Sisters Equine Refuge, working with abused and neglected horses.
